



## **OVERVIEW OF PROCESSING OPERATIONS FOR THE EXTRACTIVE AND MINERALS PROCESSING INDUSTRIES - LEVEL 3**

In order to achieve this award a total of 6 **UNITS** must be completed. Four additional units are available for completion, although they are not essential to achieve this award. However, for those not wishing, or able to achieve the full award, **UNIT CREDIT CERTIFICATES** are available for each unit successfully completed.

*NB: The following qualification structure and units make up the industrial pathway for this award which is aimed at those operating in contexts other than educational establishments for which a separate pathway is available.*
